Came to Canada as a refugee?



Kick start your career in Canada. Join the Hope To Work (H2W) Program!

H2W is a two week program that helps you set career goals and plan how to achieve them.

The program is part of a research project where 60 individuals will be recruited. 30 out of 60 will be randomly selected for the program. Individuals in the program may qualify to receive a training allowance for participation. The rest of the group will receive an honorarium for completing research surveys.

The program will be offered twice - the last two weeks of November 2016 and February 2017. Participants will learn new skills, improve their job search strategies and connect with four employers by touring their places of business and finding out about their hiring needs.

Who is eligible to participate in H2W?

- Refugees living in Canada for 10 years or less
- Unemployed and looking for full time work
- Legally able to work in British Columbia
- Have at least 10 years of education (may not be continuous)
- Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) > level 4
- Contact your nearest WorkBC to book an appointment with a Case Manager
